Exam Pattern

Stage 1: Written Examination (MCQ Based)

- **Duration:** 2 Hours
- **Total Questions:** 100 (Objective, MCQ type)
- **Maximum Marks:** 100
- **Marking Scheme:**
 - +1 mark for every correct answer
 - No negative marking for wrong or unattempted answers

Section-wise Distribution:

1. General Knowledge & Logical Knowledge – 40 Marks
2. Intellectual Ability & Mental Aptitude – 30 Marks
3. Science & Simple Mathematics – 30 Marks

→ Candidates will be shortlisted for **Stage 2 (Physical Test)** in a ratio of **7 times the number of vacancies**, based on cut-off marks.

Stage 2: Physical Efficiency Test (PET)

- Conducted under the supervision of a committee appointed by the DGP.
- Marks obtained in PET will be **added to the written exam marks** for final merit list preparation.
- Minimum 30% marks (30 out of 100) are compulsory in PET.
- No separate cut-off for horizontal categories.
- Once scheduled, PET dates will not be changed.

Detailed Syllabus

1. General Knowledge & Logical Knowledge (40 Marks)

- **Indian History** – Ancient, Medieval & Modern History, Important Dynasties, Freedom Struggle.
- **Geography** – Indian & World Geography, Climate, Rivers, Physical Features.
- **Indian Polity** – Constitution, Fundamental Rights, Parliament, State Government, Political System.
- **Current Affairs** – National & International Events, Awards, Sports, Government Schemes.
- **Logical Reasoning** – Analogy, Classification, Coding-Decoding, Blood Relation, Series, Puzzles.

2. Intellectual Ability & Mental Aptitude (30 Marks)

- Problem Solving & Decision Making
- Mathematical & Analytical Reasoning
- Observation Tests
- Memory-based Questions
- Situational Judgment and Aptitude

3. Science & Simple Mathematics (30 Marks)

Science:

- **Physics** – Motion, Force, Work, Energy, Gravitation.
- **Chemistry** – Matter, Elements, Compounds, Acids & Bases.
- **Biology** – Human Body Systems, Diseases, Nutrition, Plants & Environment.

Mathematics:

- Simplification
- Percentage
- Ratio & Proportion
- Average
- Profit & Loss
- Time & Work
- Time, Speed & Distance

Physical Efficiency Test (PET) – Key Points

- Conducted under strict supervision.
- Candidates equal to **7 times the number of vacancies** will be called for PET.
- PET performance is evaluated out of **100 Marks**, with a minimum **30 Marks qualifying requirement**.
- PET marks will be combined with the written examination marks to prepare the final merit list.

Important Note for Candidates

- Final merit will be prepared based on **Written Exam + PET Marks**.
- No separate cut-off will be released for horizontal reservations.
- The minimum qualifying marks will depend on the **dynamic cut-off**, which may vary.

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
